CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each exhibitor is limited to 4 entries per class.
- All exhibits must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor.
- Entrants must be over 16 years old. Children's art will be handled separately by the AP&H Society See SECTION 8 JUNIOR ART & CRAFT.
- No exhibit is to have been previously exhibited in the Goulburn Show.
- Stewards have the right and final decision to place entries into a class other than that nominated by the entrant if there is a more suitable class available.
- **Paintings, drawings etc. WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED unless they are ready for hanging with D-rings or Eye screws and wire or covered wires attached, NO string please. If you are in doubt about the hanging process, there are many tutorials on the internet or speak to the steward (see contact details above).**
- **The entry label which you have printed (without your name) should be attached to the wire on the back of the artwork with sticky tape.**

Oil Acrylic, Watercolour, Pastel etc. May include mixed media/collage elements

DRAWING

Class 10006 Drawing - Any Subject
Pencil, Charcoal, Conte, Pen & Ink, etc. May include mixed media/ collage elements

DIGITAL GENERATED ART

Class 10007 Any Subject
Computer generated image to be presented ready for hanging

SCULPTURE

Class 10008 Sculpture - Any Medium - stone, metal, wood, resin, cement, clay or mixed media.
Any technique - carving, casting, modelling or mixed media assemblage.

Maximum weight 25kg. Maximum height 2 metres (including any plinth).

Must not exceed 1 square metres in base area. Artist must supply own plinth or display stand if required.

Plinth must be labelled with the exhibitor's name and entry label secured with masking tape.

If no plinth is provided by the exhibitor, the sculpture will be displayed on the floor or a table.

SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS This section is for senior groups, aged care, disability groups etc.

Class 10009 Any painting or drawing – MUST be ready for hanging.
CARERS, please ensure you assist your clients to present their art works ready for hanging.
