- Entry forms and fees will be taken at the GOULBURN BASKETBALL STADIUM, Braidwood Road, Gate 5 from 11am to 6pm on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> February, Thursday 21<sup>st</sup>, Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> then the last day will be Monday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2019 from 9am to 6pm.
- Exhibits are to be delivered to the **VEOLIA ARENA** Braidwood Road, Gate 4 on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019 before 6pm. May be posted or hand delivered.
- Collection of exhibits will be from 4pm on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> March until 5pm. Exhibits not collected by the close of the pavilion may be collected from the show office on Monday afternoon between 2pm and 4pm.
- Entry Fees: Adults \$1per item
- Prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$5, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$3 unless otherwise stated
- Junior Section: No entry fee. Prizes will be ribbons, unless otherwise stated

#### **CONDITION OF ENTRY**

- All work must be COMPLETED, clean and the sole work of the exhibitor.
- No exhibit to be entered in more than one category and must have been completed in the last 2 years and not have been exhibited at a previous Goulburn Show.
- A limit of 4 items in each category per exhibitor.
- Categories may be split at the judge's discretion.
- PLEASE NOTE. All entries falling outside judging requirements will be displayed, but may not be judged.

# **EMBROIDERY WORK**

# FRAMED WORK SHOULD BE NO LARGER THAN 60cm x 50cm

- 501. Cross stitch must be presented in completed format on CLOTH, not CANVAS
- **502.** Any other item of embroidery with the main focus of hand work (can be completed by sewing machine)
- 503. Wool embroidery, any article
- **504.** Any other item of embroidery not mentioned above

#### **CANVAS WORK and TAPESTRY**

## FRAMED WORK (NO LARGER THAN 60cm x 50cm)

This must be presented in completed format.

505. Long stitch

506. Cross stitch

**507.** Any other item of canvas or tapestry work not mentioned above

#### **CHAMPION EXHIBIT Class 501 to 507**

#### PATCHWORK, APPLIQUE AND QUILTING

Due to space limitations quilts may need to be folded to be displayed.

## NO MAX SIZE REQUIRED.

Quilts which are quilted by others, (i.e. commercially quilted), must be declared on entry forms.

- **508.** Primarily pieced quilt, by maker, machine quilted by other
- **509.** Predominately appliquéd quilt
- 510. Patchwork cushion, which may include appliqué and embroidery
- **511.** Patchwork bag, which may include appliqué and embroidery
- 512. Any other item of quilting, (which may include wall hangings or table runners), not mentioned above

#### **MACHINE SEWING**

- 513. Garment, machine made
- **514.** Article, machine made
- **515.** Mixed media garment or article. Various techniques can be used including knitting, tatting, crochet, embroidery and beading to create a functional piece
- **516.** Creative article made from old jeans
- **517.** Smocking and Heirloom work
- **518.** Any other item of machine sewing not mentioned above

#### **DOLLS, TOYS AND TEDDY BEARS**

- **519.** Dressed doll or teddy bear (clothing must be made by exhibitor)
- 520. Toy or teddy bear machine made
