Conditions of Showing

- General regulations as per Goulburn Show Society
- Stud Classes open to Registered Fullbloods
- Registration Papers to be available if needed on arrival.
- Animals to be free of external parasites/lice & must not have any bald or open abscesses. Inspection on arrival.
- Animals must remain on grounds until completion of Judging on Sun 3rd March. Unless by special arrangement with the approval of the Administrators.
- Limited space available for safe penning & exhibiting Once area full entries may be declined or asked to reduce numbers.
- Age to be calculated from day of show 2nd March 2023.
- No Stud insignia to be worn/visible in ring during judging.
- Casual tidy attire with closed in shoes.
- All exhibits must have NLIS compliant tag.
- Classes may be altered depending on numbers of entries.
- Classes with less than 3 entries will be merged with an adjoining class or sectioned cancelled.
- Any Class with greater than 12 entries will be considered to add a Class as feasible.
